INSTRUCTIONS TO AUTHORS

MANUSCRIPTS :

Papers should be typed in double-spacing on one side of the paper with sufficient margins. Two copies of the manuscript should by submitted. Papers may be written in either Arabic or English, with an English summary in Arabic papers.

The main headings of paper (apart from reviews, notes and letters to the editors) should include : Introduction, materials and methods, results, discussion, a brief summary and references.

TABLES :

The tables must be of self-explanatory, and should be typed on separate sheets.

FIGURES (LINE DRAWINGS AND PLATES) :

legends should be concise and typed on a separate sheet. Numbering should be in soft pencil at the back of each figure.

The approximate position of tables and figures should be indicated in the manuscript.

TITLE :

The title of the article must be concise. Full name and address of the author(s) and Institution in which the work has been conducted should be stated. Change of address of the author(s) may be given as a foot-note. A short title, if necessary, should be provided for the running head-lines.

REFERENCES :

Arrangement of the reference list should be in alphabetical order of surnames and arranged as follows:

Sewell, G.W.F. and J.F. Wilson (1966). Verticillium wilt of the hops; studies of fluctuating cutbreaks in wilt resistant varieties. Ann appl. Biol. 58, 251-255.

In the text, a reference should be quoted by the authors' name and date (in parentheses), i.e., Jones and Wilson (1966). Authors should check that all references in the text appear in the reference list and vice-verse, and that names and dates are the same in both places.

Authors will receive thirty copies of reprints. Extra copies may be ordered on receipt of proofs, but not afterwards.

Short notes, review articles, book reviews (on agriculture) and letters-to-the editors may be accepted for publication.

The Editorial Board assumes no responsibility for the facts or opinions expressed in the Journal.
